Our trained Energy Navigators will pre-qualify your family and assist in identifying rebates, discounts, financing, and ensure that you understand everything for which you are eligible. We will schedule your Free Home Energy Assessment (a \$400 value), that provides a detailed plan for the upgrades you can choose that will save you money and improve the comfort of your home. Our experienced Energy Navigators are not salespeople. They are here for you every step of the way. Have questions? Just ask.

The Process

1 Tell Us About Your Home

The first step is a brief conversation with a Long Island Green Homes Energy Navigator where you tell us about your home and any potential energy efficiency issues. Our Energy Navigators utilize this opportunity to explain eligible rebates, discounts, and financing.

2 Receive a Free Home Energy Assessment

We will arrange for a certified Long Island professional who will conduct a comprehensive energy assessment of your home to identify any efficiency or health and safety related issues.

3 Post Assessment

After the assessment, your certified contractor presents you with a report of your home's energy efficiency. The itemized report details each efficiency upgrade option and how each option can improve your home's comfort, savings, and efficiency. Have questions about the report? 4 Authorize the Work

You authorize any or all of the work that you would like performed by signing the final agreement with your contractor.
